## OVERVIEW OF FUNDED PARTNER

Outflow focuses on removing barriers through relationship-based poverty reduction programs that help individuals with housing, food security, employment, community connection, and family stability.

## IMPACT

### Poverty to Possibility



A man was recently diagnosed with cancer. While he was a regular at our community supper program, he had little other experience or connection to our ministry.

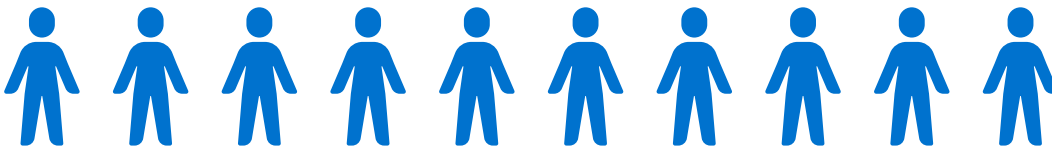
By getting to know him and his needs at our meals, he identified three significant needs in his life - the need for consistent, good, and healthy food; the need for transportation to and from his appointments; and the need for community.

Our Relationship-Based Poverty Reduction program was able to help him address all three of these needs. Helping him in these areas also gave him more confidence to discuss other challenges that he was facing, particularly as it relates to his housing situation. He now has the goal of finding better housing that both allows him to be closer to his healthcare needs and allows him to leave a housing situation where he experienced a significant personal trauma.
