Consistency & Determination - Riley's Story



Riley began attending TRC in gr. 8. Although friendly, they kept mostly to themselves & few friends and continued this way during their 1st yr of h/school I. In the summer they signed up for guitar lessons 1x a week with TRC volunteer.

With all the changes of the COVID-19, Riley remained consistent, attending lessons & soon began practicing in drop-in between lessons. A TRC staff who also played guitar began joining Riley for impromptu jam sessions. Riley enjoyed playing so much that they asked for a guitar for Christmas. This was a turning point for Riley, their skills improved quickly.

They joined a music group at school & began playing with & for other youth in drop-in, even singing in front of others & helping others learn. Riley's confidence & joy has slowly spilled over to other parts of their life as well, they are more out-going, are trying lots of new things like joining the TRC dance team.
