Teen Resource Centre

Milltown Elementary School

65 kids and families received support from MES programs that improved school attendance, physical and mental health, and more.

94% of kids in the Sylvan Tutoring program improved their reading levels.

Blacks Harbour School

92% of kids in the After School program improved their literacy skills.

100% of kids in the After School program learned 5 or more life skills (cooking, hygiene, etc).

89% of kids attending the After School program improved their self-management and personal responsibility.

100% of kids who attended the Summer Brain Gain program improved or maintained their literacy levels over summer.

Milltown Elementary School

18 kids in the Summer Slide program improved their reading levels.

Blacks Harbour School

25 kids attended Summer Slide camp and 72% improved or maintained their numeracy levels.

Previous to joining the After School program at Blacks Harbour School, Kylie had very poor attendance at school. Once enrolled, her attendance began to increase as she looked forward to attending the program everyday.



Based on that success, it was decided to enroll Kylie in the Summer Slide program also. She missed minimal time and made amazing strides in her literacy and numeracy, increasing her levels in both, which was fantastic!

Kylie continues to attend the After School program this year and her school attendance remains strong.
