But she had not yet healed.

She turned to Sophia Recovery Centre, joining a trauma recovery group, participating in counselling and attending meditation and art programs.

Amy's story: Pregnant and alone



Amy was pregnant and alone, living in her car on the streets of Saint John.

In her desperate circumstances, she turned to Outflow Ministry, a charity that works with people in Saint John who live in poverty

by helping to address unemployment, hunger, homelessness, and medical costs.

Outflow, a United Way funded partner, was able to help her achieve her own goals of finding an apartment before her baby arrived and retrieving her furniture from a storage unit.
