Saint John has the highest rate of violence against young girls

Kids who grow up with domestic violence are more than 5 times more likely to be abused or be abusive as adults

#### HELP MAKE MENTAL HEALTH #UNIGNORABLE

■ 30% of people in Saint John struggle with mental health

■ 45% of people with mental health issues are victims of crime

➤ On average, it takes over a year for someone struggling with mental health to tell their closest friends and family
