Saint John Community Loan Fund

71% of Enterprising Women grads started a business or found employment.

Women's Empowerment Network

47 women participated in empowerment programs & 100% felt more connected to their community.

Saint John Learning Exchange

92 people secured full or part-time employment through the WorkLinks program.

Outflow

87% of individuals supported achieved their goals. 10 previously homeless individuals moved into permanent housing.

Strong and healthy communities

996 people provided with tools and services to improve their lives

5,102 free or subsidized counselling sessions

6,509 interventions to connect people with resources through 211

Increasing resiliency in individuals by breaking cycles of violence, social isolation and loneliness, and creating stronger families.

Family Plus Life Solutions

255 individuals and families accessed counselling sessions.

Second Stage Safe Haven

20 women and their children left abusive relationships. 100% of women are living free from abuse 1 year later.

First Steps Housing

28 young moms accessed parenting, life skills, and mental health support.

Sophia Recovery Centre

209 women accessed recovery support and 68% eliminated substance abuse for 6 months or longer.

Charlotte Dial-A-Ride

3,865 rides provided to access essential services.

Sussex Wellness Network

55 individuals and families connected to community supports for housing, food, etc.
